Dear Parents,

We are delighted to attach the list for clubs which we will be running in the Summer Term. Clubs will begin w/c **23rd April** and will run through to w/c **2nd July** which is a **10 week block**.

Please note NO CLUBS:

7th May 2018 - Due to Bank holiday
25th May INSET Day - staff only to attend
W/C 28th May 2018 - Half Term.

Once your child is offered a club, they are expected to attend each week unless you have notified the office or class teacher with a reason why they can't go. If a child regularly misses a club, it may affect them being given clubs in future.

All payments are to be paid directly to the club provider or via ParentPay (as stated on club sheet). A separate letter will be given from outside providers once a place is confirmed. Full payment is required regardless if your child may miss a week due to other school commitments as the cost of the clubs are worked out for the whole block and not on a weekly basis therefore refunds cannot be given.

We are proud of the range of opportunities provided by teachers and outside agencies. Our aim is to provide enjoyable and productive experiences for all concerned. Again this term, we have worked alongside Colchester United to develop a set of clear expectations in order to provide the best learning opportunities across our school clubs programme. We will be sharing these with the children, teachers, club providers and parents.

Participants can expect their Coaches and instructors to:

- Treat all participants equally
- Show respect to all participants
- Take action if participants or spectators do not follow the boundaries agreed

Participants should:

- Be on their best behaviour at all times - whilst following boundaries set out by the coach or instructor
- Respect others in the session
- Enjoy their session

Parents and spectators observing session are expected not to:

- Attempt to "coach" or "manipulate" any player while they are participating in a coaching session
- Undermine the coaches taking the session
- Assess players by their incompetence but by their values and strengths

Be aware that our policy is not to cancel any club. In the case of bad weather, children will do alternative club-related activities until the finish time. If you wish to take them home because of bad weather, please report to the School office first. As you can appreciate the office gets a high volume of telephone calls at the end of the day so we would appreciate it if you did not ring the office unless really necessary to give a message to your child to change to arrangements because of bad weather. In the interest of your child's safety, please always collect them from the front of the school after clubs finish.
