New Playground Arrangements

Lunchtime is a vitally important part of the school day for our pupils; it allows pupils to socialise in a relatively free and unstructured, safe environment which is not always available outside the school gates. Once our MUGA (multi-use games area) is finished we will be rolling out a new set of arrangements which, we hope, will enhance your child's enjoyment of this break time and impact positively on teaching and learning as a result.

Here are the key changes:

- Children to sit by class rather than meal choice when having lunch
- * The field to be used all year round where possible (Parents—please provide a change of shoes/ trainers in a plastic bag for your child to access this)
- A permanent football pitch to be sited and used every day (with goals)
- * Each year group to have a dedicated time in the MUGA and on the play equipment
- * No running on the two tarmac playgrounds or on any school paths
- * A 'House' day on a Friday to encourage wider social mixing
- * Pupil-run radio station broadcasting 3 times a week onto the playground I look forward to confirming a start date for these arrangements with you all shortly.
