#### **Single Plan Maths Focus**

The children and staff held an assembly this week to launch the new focus of our single plan for school improvement for the Spring term. Our focus is 'moving on in Maths' so that we can further improve the next steps provided to the children for them to make rapid progress in Maths. After the success of last year's open maths mornings, we will be repeating these in March. The 'live lessons' are all between 9:00-10:30am and are as follows:

- Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> March Year 5

There will be opportunities to book up to 10 spaces per classroom for this event where you will be able to work alongside your child as well as gain an insight into how we teach Maths at the school as a whole group.
