## Curriculum Enrichment Donation

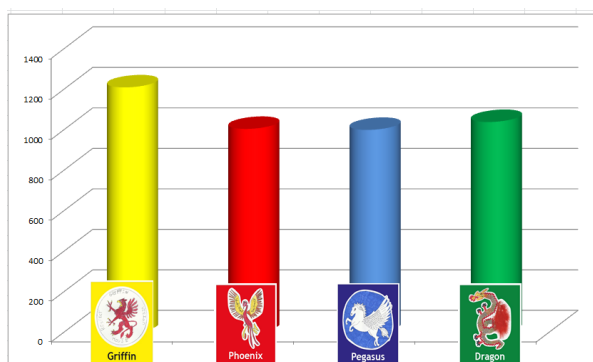
