
Positive Parental Engagement at Barnes Farm!

At the end of this week, we have begun to see a fall in the number of Covid cases reported at school. This stands at 11% of pupils with 13% the high on Monday. Our community's experience this week has been very similar to other schools locally (such as Chancellor Park) with the high transmissibility of this current variant. The fact that so many of our parents are testing their children and communicating with the school means that we are helping to minimise this spread where possible. Thank you for all of you who have used Studybugs or the remotesupport@barnesfarm-jun.essex.sch.uk email to do this. **Please continue to follow the public health guidance for close contacts if needed.**

The staff continue to be impressed with the resilience of the pupils, particularly where they have had to access remote learning. We are proud of how we include our remote learners into the heart of lessons, but do not underestimate the perseverance and dedication it takes from children and parents to access this. Unfortunately, we have had to cancel onsite provision for two classes this week (in Year 4, one day each) due to significant staffing challenges. This decision is always made in consultation with the local authority, the wider academy trust and only follows exhaustive efforts to maintain safe staffing ratios in the class. Further strengthening our relationships for learning is one of our school priorities and I am proud of our community's response to this challenge.
