# Christmas is coming...

Though it is still some weeks away, we know you will appreciate receiving some more detailed information about our Christmas plans at school.

#### **FOBFS PTA events**

The PTA is busy organising two events for pupils and their families towards the end of this term. The first is the Winter Bazaar, which will be held on **Saturday 25**<sup>th</sup> **November** between 2-4pm across both schools. Stalls with gifts, toys, food and games will be on offer, as well as refreshments and presentations from Infant and Junior School choirs.

The second event is the Christmas Craft Morning, where pupils from both schools have the opportunity to create a variety of Christmas-themed crafts. This will be held on **Saturday 9**<sup>th</sup> **December** from 10-12pm in the Junior School hall. Information about this will be sent out later this month.

### Year 3 and Year 4 Christmas Services

As usual, both Year 3 and Year 4 are preparing Christmas presentations this term which will take place as follows:

Our very popular Christmas lunch will be served on **Tuesday 19**<sup>th</sup> **December**. This is always a fun event and both regular and vegetarian options will be available. As this is usually a high-demand lunch, a separate letter and booking slip will be sent to you closer to the time in order to assist the catering team to prepare accordingly.
