
PSHE-Themed Day - Monday 27th September

As part of our regular Essex safeguarding updates, staff were made aware of some of the risks (and benefits) to children of using in-game chat apps such as Discord. This is an app which allows in-game chat (once installed) and can be great fun when used safely with friends. Please read this link from the Net-Aware website which describes some of the features. Concerns have been raised that some adult players in games such as Minecraft etc are putting in links to Discord so that children then appear to be playing Minecraft but are actually then chatting to a stranger at the same time.
