- 3 T-shirts
- Shoes/trainers one comfortable old pair for walking
- Slippers/indoor shoes
- Numerous pairs of socks
- Underwear for five days
- Two plastic bin liners one for worn clothes, one for sitting on
- Pyjamas/onesie/dressing gown
- Two towels one for beach (paddling)
- Washing kit (flannel, soap, toothbrush, hairbrush, comb, etc.) No aerosols.
- A stamped addressed postcard (to be posted home on arrival)
- Extra stamps are useful
- Sun cream
- Sun hat/glasses
- One outfit for disco/theatre
- Alarm clock (small)
- Flipflops, plastic shoes/crocs for the beach are handy

HAND BAGGAGE

Small <u>named</u> rucksack (comfortable for walking) containing:
