#### **Dealing with Change**

It has been another busy week of learning here at school as well as continued change linked to dealing with Covid-19. On Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January the national guidance changes around self-isolation periods. Therefore the following applies:

 Under the guidance that comes into effect on Monday 17 January, it is a requirement to self-isolate for 5 full days, therefore people cannot leave isolation on Day 5 but they can on Day 6 (following two negative tests, taken 24 hours apart)

Please continue to use lateral flow tests (twice a week unless advised to test daily if close contact) if not too distressing for your child. Thank you to all those parents who have let us know outcomes - we wish them and their children well during this time. I would also like to acknowledge the great work our teachers are doing by including these remote learners into everyday learning. We reported 5.5% of pupils as positive cases this week, with 7.5% of staff affected. Next week sees Maths Day on Monday as well as our Parent Consultations on Tuesday/Thursday via Microsoft Teams -you can still book an appointment via eschools.
