## Some ideas include:

- Make a list of sustainably sourced food items found in your local supermarket.
- Look in your fridge. Is anything unnecessarily wrapped in plastic? Write a letter to the company or supermarket explaining why we should do away with single-use plastics.
- Write a fact file about Marina Silva, Sir David Attenborough, William Kamkwamba, Melati and Isabel Wijsen, or another "Earth Hero"
- Make beeswax wraps to use in your packed lunches.
- Create a compost bin in your garden.
- Learn how to sew up holes in your old clothes so they can be reworn.
- Pick up litter in our community.
- Make your own soap, cleaning products, shampoo or conditioner using natural ingredients.
- Keep a diary of how much waste your family produces each week and what can be recycled, reused or composted.
- Upcycle rubbish to create something new and useful, or a piece of art for your home.
- Calculate your carbon footprint on footprint.wwf.org.uk. How will you offset this?
- Create a poster about the 2019 Amazon rainforest wildfires or the bushfires currently burning in Australia. Persuade others to donate to these causes.
