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Silence for Grenfell observed on Monday

Once again, the whole school shared with the rest of the country in observing the government's request for a one-minute silence on Monday in remembrance of those who have been affected by the fire at Grenfell Tower in London. Mr McTaggart talked to the children at the end of assembly. The information shared was basic and brief, so that parents can decide how much and in what way to discuss the events:

- This is to remember all those who were affected by fire in a high-rise tower block that happened last week in the London
- We show togetherness as a country and our respect and compassion towards others by doing this
- As part of upholding the British value of 'rule of law', we were observing the silence along with the rest of the country.

The 1 minute silence was then held as the 'reflection time' usually held at the end of the assembly.
