

Bag2School Recycling

The PTA are trialing a new recycling venture. Bag2School are a company that collects old clothing, shoes, handbags, jewelry, soft toys etc and unlike some recycling companies Bag2School passes these used items on to countries within Eastern Europe to be sold on to those less fortunate. Items that are not saleable are recycled. For every tonne in weight of recycling we can collect the school will get £500. Watch out for further details about this scheme which will be launched in October. Start saving your old clothes now and help raise funds for the schools. Don't forget paired shoes can be added - every bit of weight helps us get more in return.
