

How to check eligibility for Free School Meals


You can check your free school meals eligibility by accessing the website:<u>https://pps.lgfl.org.uk/</u>




• Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the check availability button. You will be taken to the following page:



- Click on the blue proceed button 'Create a new account'
- Select Essex from the Local Authority List and then your child's school from the drop down list and press next

(If your child is in Reception, Year 1, or Year 2 (i.e. Key Stage 1) then Free School Meals will be provided regardless of your eligibility. The importance of this test is to alert the school about those Key Stage 1 parents who would be eligible for Free School Meals if the government was not already providing them, because schools can claim additional funding for themselves as a result of such pupils.)

• If you are eligible you will have the option to print a certificate. Please send a copy of the certificate (even just a screenshot on your phone) to the school.
